This course will enable teachers to listen to, and work with, Dr Mark Gardiner of Lincoln University on the topic of Castle Acre Priory. Castle Acre Priory is the historic environment site for the AQA GCSE Normans paper in 2022. Dr Mark Gardiner is an Associate Professor at the University of Lincoln, specialising in late medieval archaeology. He was previously joint head of Archaeology at Queen's University Belfast. He has directed excavations in England, in Scotland, Northern Ireland and Norway. He was formerly President of the Society for Medieval Archaeology and is currently a Vice-President of the Royal Archaeological Institute.
