Do you have significant teaching experience and looking to obtain Qualified Teachers Status (QTS)?

IF SO, THIS MIGHT BE THE ROUTE FOR YOU!

The Assessment Only Route recognises the experience that unqualified teachers have gained during their professional career.

If you already have a degree, and significant teaching experience in planning, teaching and assessing, then you can achieve QTS (Qualified Teacher Status) in as little as one term, through the AO (Assessment Only) Route.

ENTRY CRITERIA:

- All entrants have achieved a standard equivalent to a grade 4 in GCSE English and mathematics.
 - All those who intend to teach pupils aged 3 to 11 additionally have achieved a standard equivalent to a grade 4 in a GCSE science subject.
 - All entrants hold a first degree* of a United Kingdom Higher Education Institution or equivalent qualification.
 - All entrants have taught in at least two schools, early years and/or further education settings.
 - All entrants have taken part in a selection process designed to assess suitability to teach and the ability to demonstrate meeting all of the Teachers' Standards without the need for any further training.
